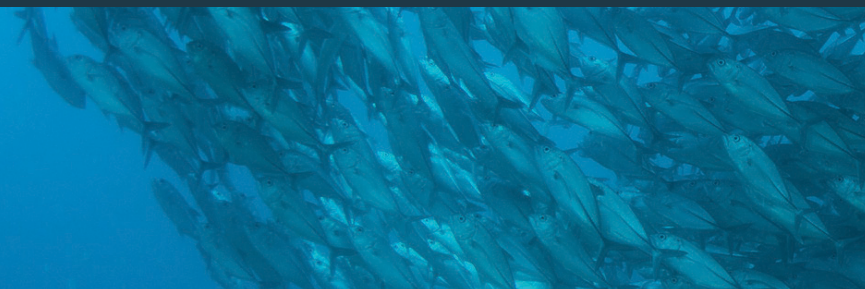

Objective

The project's objective was to promote monitoring of marine protected areas and the natural resources of Mexican seas, to understand the state of marine and coastal resources, and to encourage synergies that avoid duplication of efforts, facilitating decision-making.

Lines of work

- 1 Development of a marine and coastal monitoring platform.
- 2 Generation of information on the coverage and distribution of red mangrove in northwestern Mexico and the Yucatan Peninsula.



- 3 Diagnosis of aquaculture in Mexico for the identification of lines of action towards sustainability.

Achievements

Monitoring and validation of **red mangrove** distribution maps in Mexico.

Consolidation of **infoCEANOS**: metadata platform with marine and coastal monitoring and research information.

Data updated at the end of 2023.
